Approval / Review of April 2024 Board Meeting Minutes: motion to approve by: Kyle E.; seconded by: Traci L.; unanimous approval of the minutes.

GM Report (Rob W.): April was a good month; revenue is outpacing budget; we had payroll savings; some overages in operating expenses associated with Spring Cleaning/Maintenance, but our overall April savings did counter these additional costs. Discussion as to the Spring Cleaning / Maintenance which was done and why it was necessary. Supplies are definitely more expensive in 2024 (comparison to 2023). F&B did save us money. Fully hired for Grounds Dept., and fully hired for Golf, and Kitchen staff is fully hired as well. Still filling out the Life-guarding staff. We are ready for pool and full swing golf season. Memberships: 30 sold as of today versus a budget of 46. Dues line is healthy and strong right now.

Old Business: presented by Rob W.

Bunker Project: They (Verde) are down to the last hole or two; they could be done and out by Memorial Day; we are making a Punch list of work / repair work to be done including concrete, and any concrete work will be quoted and done by Mayfield Construct.

Bridge Project: 7/8 Bridge is repaired but we are worried about noise level and hold the boards in place and make them less Bouncy to make sure it has good, long term health; Bridge on #16 and repair work to it, that will come in the next few weeks; Bridge #10: small project, not structurally an issue; it is sound, just making it look better

Lockers: we are looking into updating and re-marketing the wine/liquor locker program; we are not sold out; people are using them; but we are Going to re-engage membership; note: all folks who had one last year did re-up for 2024. The good news is people who have the Lockers are indeed using the lockers. Golf Carts: Cordale took point and contacted Membership about proof of insurance for cart owners; stickers are on their way And will be handed out soon; this program is going well.

New Business:

Tennis: Rob, Toney T. and Gordon (Tennis Pro) are setting up an initial meeting to kick-off the long term tennis plan for The LFCC tennis complex. After this initial meeting we are going to bring in membership for their help, expertise and input.
